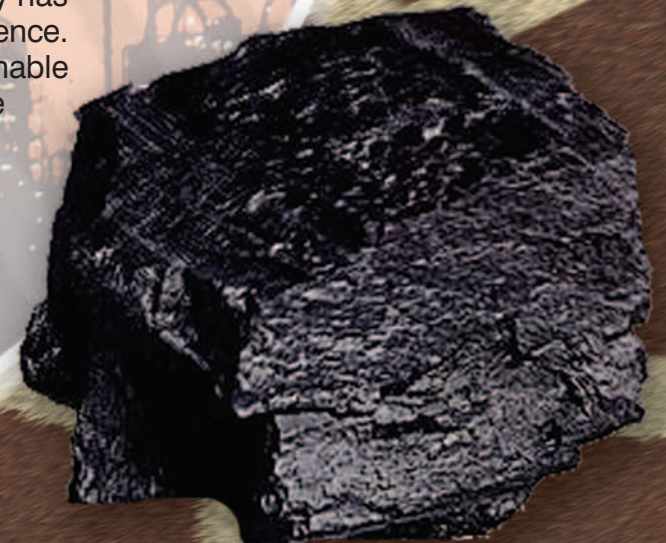
The South African Coal Processing Society will host the Coal Preparation Conference and Exhibition in parallel with The Twenty-Fourth International Pittsburgh Coal Conference

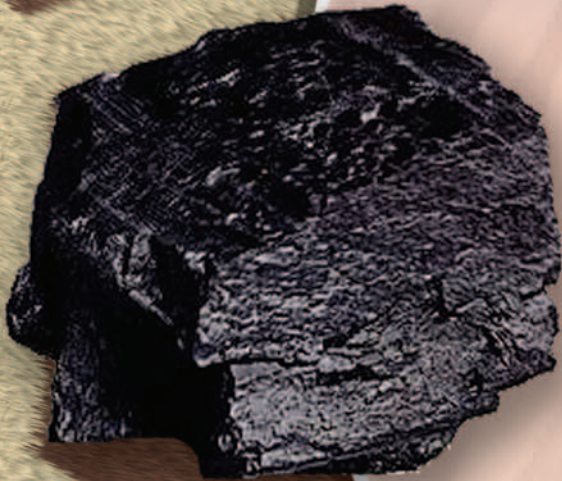
10 – 14 September 2007
